1. 2020-2021 Budget Discussion

Councilmember Galbreath questioned the differences between the previous budget that was discussed and the current budget they were reviewing. The Mayor explained that the previous budget was based on actual numbers through May 31, 2020. The current budget under review was based on actual numbers through July 31, 2020. This resulted in some of the projected revenues and appropriations to change.

Councilmember Galbreath also questioned if CRI Accounting Firm had been consulted on how to report the FEMA and insurance revenues and appropriations vs. normal operating numbers. City Clerk Griffin said she would follow up on that for the next meeting.

Councilmember Galbreath questioned the reporting of Infrastructure Sales Surtax funds. City Clerk Griffin would follow up with the auditors on this topic, too.

Councilmember Galbreath was not comfortable including the projected revenue from 50 of the 270 new apartments scheduled to be constructed at East Bay Flats. Mayor Musgrave agreed to remove that portion of the revenue.

Once these answers are obtained, another budget workshop will be scheduled.
