SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTING REFERENCE STORM DEBRIS SERVICES

WHEREAS the CITY of PARKER, FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as "THE CITY" has been devastated by storms in the past generating debris on public and private property within THE CITY; and

WHEREAS, the threat of such storms still exist; and

WHEREAS, debris removal is an obligation of THE CITY as a matter of public policy to protect the public health and safety and to ensure the economic recovery of THE CITY; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has chosen to be prepared to respond to the potential storm threat; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has sought, received and reviewed information and debris removal pricing from firms specializing in such removal, reduction and disposal; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has determined that the pre-storm contract of Crowder-Gulf contains the best value offer for this critical emergency response and recovery work; and


WHEREAS, THE CITY has determined that the pricing contained in the contract is fair and reasonable for the contracted Scope of Services compared to payments made by THE CITY in the past for similar work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:


The City Council of THE CITY of PARKER, FLORIDA does hereby approve and instruct the Mayor to enter into a pre-storm contract with Disaster Recovery and Debris Management to remove and dispose of all eligible storm-generated debris in the storm effected area of the CITY of PARKER, FLORIDA, as set out in the contracted Scope of Services.

RESOLUTION NO. 05-244
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida (the "Council"), has been advised by the Bay County Board of County Commissioners Chief of Emergency Services that: **Hurricane Dennis** has formed and will be in the Gulf of Mexico and threatens the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Parker; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, when a disaster threatens the citizens of the City of Parker the Council has the authority to declare a local state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, the Council authorizes the Mayor to declare a Local State of Emergency when and if the Bay County Board of County Commissioners Chief of Emergency Services advises the Mayor that such a declaration is prudent; and,

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Parker may need to seek shelter in a secure area until the threat of **Hurricane Dennis** has subsided; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida, as follows:

1. Declaration of Local State of Emergency. Due to **Hurricane Dennis** the Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to declare that a Local State of Emergency exists in and for the City of Parker when the Bay County Board of County Commissioners Chief of Emergency Services advises the Mayor that such a declaration is necessary. As such advice has been given, the Mayor hereby declares a Local State of Emergency.
2. Exercise of Powers. The authority and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida and the City of Parker during emergencies are hereby activated.
3. Resolution to be sent to Governor. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Governor of the State of Florida.
