

RESOLUTION 4

WHEREAS SR-22 is presently constructed from Panama City, Florida, to Wewahitchka, Florida; and

WHEREAS an extension of SR-22 from Wewahitchka to Perry is an absolute necessity, not only for the Panhandle area of Florida, but for traffic from the North and West with destinations in South Florida; and

WHEREAS this proposed construction of SR-22 would be the most direct route from West Florida to South Florida; and

WHEREAS all of the counties and many municipalities and groups interested in the construction of SR-22 have previously urged the State Road Department of Florida to take the necessary action to construct said road because of its importance to each of them; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the State Road Department of Florida is hereby urged to undertake the extension of SR-22 to Perry, Florida, at the earliest practicable time.
