W H E R E A S, the City Council of the City of Parker has heretofore resolved to install water transmission lines across State Road 22-A prior to the paving of said road, and

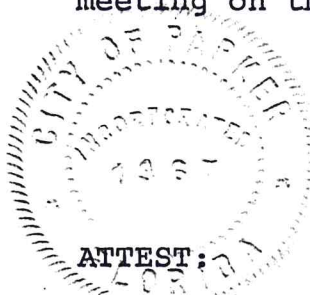
W H E R E A S, said installation will constitute part of the construction of a municipal water system to be carried out in the near future, and
