

RESOLUTION 16

The City Council of the City of Parker in Bay County, Florida,
at a special meeting duly called (a quorum being present) held on the
8th day of June, 1971, 5:30 P. M. unanimously passed
and adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that Springfield Commercial Bank being designated
as a depository of this City and that funds of the City deposited in said
bank be subject to withdrawal upon checks for the payment of money when
signed on behalf of this City by any two of the following officers, to wit:

BE IT RESOLVED that the above bank be authorized to transfer one
hundred dollars (\$100.00) from the Savings Account as set up for the City
and designated as "Water Deposits", and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that checks may be drawn on the above account
for refunds of water deposits only.
