WHEREAS, said highway traverses a populated residential area, and

WHEREAS, speed limit signs are needed to control the speed of vehicles on said highway,

NOW, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council by unanimous vote that the speed limit of Hickory Street should be set at 35 miles per hour,

RESOLVED further that the SR Dept. post appropriate speed limit signs to warn motorists accordingly.
