

RESOLUTION NO. 54

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Parker:

WHEREAS, the City of Parker has submitted an application to the State of Florida for the acquisition of the following parcels of land for the sum of Forty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$42,500.00).


Northerly Parcel: From a concrete monument on the West R/W line of Old U.S. Highway 98 which concrete monument is 135 feet Southeasterly along said West R/W line from the SE corner of Lot 2 of Long Point Park First Addition plat, run S11°00'W, 1413.7 feet to a point on said West R/W line; thence East, 100 feet to the East R/W line of Old U.S. Highway 98 and the point of beginning of this description; thence Northerly along said East R/W line, 168.5 feet; thence East, 210 feet, more or less, to the water's edge of East Bay; thence Southwesterly along the water's edge of East Bay, 176 feet, more or less, to a point East of the point of beginning; thence West, 155 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing 0.7 acres, more or less.

Southerly Parcel: From a concrete monument of the West R/W line of Old U.S. Highway 98 which concrete monument is 135 feet Southeasterly along said West R/W line from the SE corner of Lot 2 of Long Point Park First Addition plat, run S11°00'W, 1413.7 feet to a point on said West R/W line; thence East 100 feet to the East R/W line of Old U.S. Highway 98; thence Southerly along said East R/W line, 332.6 feet to the point of beginning of this description; thence continue Southerly and Southwesterly along the curved East R/W line of old U.S. Highway 98, 660 feet, more or less, to the water's edge of St. Andrew Bay; thence Southeasterly along said water's edge, 280 feet, more or less, to a point of land at the entrance to East Bay; thence Northeasterly along the water's edge of East Bay, 880 feet, more or less, to a point East of the point of beginning; thence West, 85 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing 2.5 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker resolves to include the above parcels of land as an addition to the now existing Earl Gilbert Park and;

WHEREAS, the City of Parker further resolves to develop said parcels of land according to the attached site plan and will operate and maintain this site as Earl Gilbert Park for perpetuity.
