

RESOLUTION NO. 68

WHEREAS, the City of Parker has applied to the Environmental Protection Agency and to the Farmers Home Administration for grants and loans for the purpose of constructing a new central sewage system to serve the inhabitants of the City of Parker, and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker recognizes that Environmental Protection Agency regulations require the development of cost systems for the operation of the new central sewage system, including a requirement for the development of an industrial cost recovery system, and

WHEREAS, at the present time there are no known industrial sources that will contribute to the new central sewage system and therefore the City Council is of the opinion that the industrial cost recovery system (ICR) requirement is not applicable, and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker recognizes that all users of the system will pay their appropriate share of operation and maintenance costs, therefore, the City Council of the City of Parker will cooperate with the Bay County Board of County Commissioners to take all actions as may be necessary to develop a proper user charge system, including, if required, an industrial cost recovery (ICR) system that will meet the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Parker, Bay County, Florida that said Council shall cooperate with the Bay County Board of County Commissioners to develop a user charge system that will provide that users of the new central sewage system will pay their appropriate share of operation and maintenance cost of the system and that said user charge shall meet all requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency including, if applicable, and industrial cost recovery (ICR) system,
