

A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED: A RESOLUTION TO CONTINUE MEMBERSHIP IN THE WEST FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 160, FLORIDA STATUTES OF 1980, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, Chapter 160, Florida Statutes of 1980 provides for the creation of a Regional Planning Council in each of the several comprehensive planning districts of the State; and

WHEREAS, the existing Regional Planning Council in each of the several comprehensive planning districts shall be designated as the Regional Planning Council in their district provided the Council agrees to meet the membership criteria specified in Chapter 160, Florida Statutes of 1980; and

WHEREAS, the West Florida Regional Planning Council has agreed to meet the membership criteria specified in Chapter 160, Florida Statutes of 1980; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the West Florida Regional Planning Council that all participating units of local government express their intent to continue their membership on the Council in accordance with the new membership requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker, Florida is presently a member of the West Florida Regional Planning Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Parker, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Parker, Florida agrees to continue its membership on the West Florida Regional Planning Council pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 160, Florida Statutes of 1980, as amended.

SECTION 2. That the City of Parker, Florida shall have 1 representative(s) on the West Florida Regional Planning Council who shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida, and shall hold office at the will of the City Council.

SECTION 3. That the said West Florida Regional Planning Council shall act in an advisory capacity to the constituent local governments in regional, metropolitan, county and municipal planning matters.

SECTION 4. That the City of Parker, Florida shall pay its pro-rata share of such costs of the West Florida Regional Planning Council as the City of Parker, Florida shall determine to be reasonable and proper.
