A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED REDUCTION OF LOCAL
GOVERNMENT HALF-CENT SALES TAX TRUST FUND

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER:


WHEREAS, the Governor of Florida ("Governor") has proposed and the Legislature of Florida is considering the imposition by the State of Florida ("State") of a three percent (3%) service fee on the Local Government Half-Cent Sales Tax Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker desires to officially oppose any service charge on the Local Government Half-Cent Sales Tax Trust Fund including that currently proposed by the Governor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Parker, Florida, that the City of Parker opposes any service fee on the Local Government Half-Cent Sales Tax Trust Fund including, but not limited to, the current proposal by the Governor for the imposition of a surcharge of three percent (3%).
