

RESOLUTION NO. 139

WHEREAS, the West Florida Regional Planning Council has been in existence since 1964 and represents the wishes of units of local government to have a Regional Planning Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council consisting of elected officials representing fifteen (15) units of local government, and seven (7) governor appointees, believes it is in the best interest of local governments to continue its operations; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Land Management Study Committee III and the Advisory Council on Intergovernmental Relations have gone on record supporting the continuation of Regional Councils; and


WHEREAS, the Council opposes the sunseting of Regional Planning Councils as called for in Chapter 92-182.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Parker City Council acting by and through its members, supports re-enactment of the Florida Regional Planning Council Act and repeal of Chapter 92-182, Laws of Florida; and
