

RESOLUTION NO. 140

WHEREAS, Federal Coastal Management Program Funds are available from the Florida Department of Community Affairs for coastal management-related planning; and

WHEREAS, stormwater management planning is an eligible use of grant funds under the Coastal Management Program; and

WHEREAS, pollution from uncontrolled stormwater runoff represents a common problem which crosses local jurisdictional boundaries posing a potential threat to the water of the entire estuarine system; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Panama City, Parker, Callaway, Lynn Haven and Panama City Beach, as well as Bay County are eligible to receive Coastal Management Program Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned local governments mutually agree that use of Coastal Management Program Grant Funds for preparation of a coordinated, interjurisdictional Stormwater Control Plan is a desirable and appropriate use of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY, that the City of Parker City Council acting by and through its members supports the Cities of Panama City, Parker, Callaway, Lynn Haven and Panama City Beach, as well as Bay County who will jointly participate in the development of a Stormwater Control Plan using Coastal Management Program Grant Funds, if awarded and Bay County will apply for and take the lead in the distribution of grant funds, as may be applicable to the Stormwater control Plan.
