**WHEREAS, the City Council, although not approving any changes to current  
codes or definitions at this time, does hereby recognize the impact on economic growth that  
the lack of uniform Land Use Codes and their respective definitions creates and**


**WHEREAS, the City Council is interested in cooperating with other government
