

RESOLUTION 97-183 _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE TENTATIVE APPROVAL OF AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE MILITARY POINT REGIONAL ADVANCED WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, TO DANIS HEAVY CONSTRUCTION, PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM, SUBJECT TO REGULATORY APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR SUBSEQUENT EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN, OF THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR NEGOTIATIONS ON COSTS FOR ADDITIVE ALTERNATIVE BIDS; PROVIDING A FIVE PERCENT (5%) CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker wishes to utilize funds from the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program to construct the Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 1997, bids were received for the construction of the Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, Baskerville-Donovan, Inc., the systems engineer for the project has recommended tentative award of the base bid contract to Danis Heavy Construction, in the amount of Twenty Million, Seven Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$20,767,000); and

WHEREAS, The City of Parker wishes to further negotiate the Additive Alternate Bids as best meets the needs of the project, in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City of Parker tentatively awards the base bid contract for the construction of the Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility to Danis Heavy Construction, 100 Chase Park South, Suite 200, Birmingham, AL 35244, for a total amount of \$20,767,000 subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and intends to authorize subsequent execution of the contract documents by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, after staff reports back to the Board that DEP and all owners have approved such contract.

Section 2. Bay County intends to negotiate Additive Alternate Bids 1 and 2 in an amount not to exceed \$300,000, subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 3. The City of Parker authorizes, by adoption of this resolution, a contingency allowance in the amount of five percent (5%) of the contract amount equaling \$1,080,850.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida.
