

**RESOLUTION NO. 206**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PARKER,  
FLORIDA ELECTING TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF  
COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS  
LEVIED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE  
CITY; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY; PROVIDING  
FOR THE MAILING OF THIS RESOLUTION AND  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council (the "Council") of Parker, Florida (the "City" is contemplating the imposition of special assessments for the provision of stormwater management services and facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem special assessments for the cost of providing stormwater management services and facilities to property within the incorporated area of the City as authorized by section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, because this method will allow such special assessments to be collected annually commencing in November, 2000 in the same manner as prescribed for ad valorem taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council held a duly advertised public hearing prior to the adoption of this Resolution, proof of publication of such hearing attached hereto as Exhibit A; and


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of Parker, Florida, as follows:

1. Commencing with the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2000 and with the tax statement for such Fiscal Year, the City intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments authorized in section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, for collecting non-ad valorem assessments for the cost of providing stormwater management services and facilities. Such non-ad valorem assessments shall be levied within the incorporated area of the City. A legal description of such area subject to the assessments is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference.
2. The City hereby determines that the levy of the assessments is needed to fund the cost of stormwater management services and facilities within the incorporated area of the City.
3. Upon adoption, the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution by United States mail to the Florida Department of Revenue, the Bay County Tax Collector and the Bay County Property Appraiser by January 10, 2000.
4. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.



PARKER BOUNDARY

Beginning at a point 33 feet South of the Northwest Corner of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, thence East along the South Right-of-Way line of Cherry Street to a point 33 feet South and 1910 feet West of the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, thence run South 297 feet, thence run East 1690 feet, thence run North 297 feet, thence run East to a point 33 feet South of the Northeast Corner of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, thence run South along East boundary line of Sections 13 and 24, Township 4 South, Range 14 West to a point on the North shore line of the East arm of St. Andrews Bay; thence run Southerly and Westerly along the meandering shore line of St. Andrews Bay 6,200 feet, more or less to the Southern tip of Long Point; thence run Northerly and Westerly along the meandering shore line of St. Andrews Bay 19,030 feet to a point which is 330 feet North of the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 4 South, Range 14 West, thence run East to a point which is 330 feet North of the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 14, thence North along the West boundary line of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 14 West to the point of beginning.
