Mayor Barrow called the meeting to order and gave the prayer. Council member Oost led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Roll Call

Council Members Miller, Nepereny, Oost, Spikes and Mayor Barrow were present.

Grandfathering of Blue Cross Blue Shield Plan

The City Clerk stated that the city's current plan with Blue Cross Blue Shield is no longer available. However, Blue Cross Blue Shield is offering the city a grandfathering of the policy. Sammy Day of Sammy Day Insurance asked the council to look at going out for bids in the future. After some discussion Council Member Oost made a motion seconded by Council Member Nepereny to authorize the Mayor to sign the grandfathering agreement. Upon taking the yeas and nays the vote was Yeas 5, Nays 0. Motion carried.

Discussion of Ready to Eat Meals

The City Clerk stated that Council Member Miller asked her to place this item back on the agenda. Council Member Miller stated that he felt the police department should be able to purchase at least a three day supply of the Ready to Eat Meals. Chief Sweatt stated that a citizen has donated some meals but there still is not enough to cover the three days. Council Member Miller made a motion to authorize the purchase of the Ready to Eat Meals. Motion died for a lack of a second.

FY2011-2012 Budget Papers

The City Clerk stated that she was presenting the Council with a balanced budget to review and it will be on the next agenda for adoption. She also provided the Council with a memo showing the FY10/11 approved budget numbers and the FY11/12 proposed numbers. She stated that she has a savings of \$114,708.00 in the General Fund budget over last years and \$125,708.00 savings in the Utility Fund over last year's budget. She then stated that the FY11/12 budget included \$68,950.00 for a proposed 10% utility tax for General Fund revenues and if the Council approved the 10% utility tax for revenues towards General Fund that there would be no funds coming from reserves to balance the FY11/12 budget. Council Member Nepereny made a motion seconded by Council Member Oost to approve the 10% utility tax to be in the FY11/12 budget. The City Clerk stated that she could leave the numbers in the budget but she would have to bring an ordinance back for the adoption at a later meeting and that it would take a little bit of time before it would go into effect. Upon taking the yeas and nays the vote was Yeas 4, Nays 1. Motion carried with Council Member Miller voting no.

Adjournment of Meeting

Mayor Barrow adjourned the meeting at 9:24am.
