

ORDINANCE 06-311

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARKER, ~~TRANSFERRING~~ ^{DECLARING} TO COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT; DECLARING THE CITY OF PARKER CITY COUNCIL TO BE THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, PART III, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 06-251 adopted by the City of Parker City Council on May 22, 2006, expressed its intention to consider the creation of a community redevelopment area; authorized a study to consider whether a finding of necessity resolution should be adopted, defined a proposed redevelopment study area within the City of Parker; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 06-254 adopted on December 18, 2006, the City Council of the City of Parker ("City"), Florida has made a finding of necessity for the creation and establishment of a community redevelopment agency; and

WHEREAS, Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes ("Redevelopment Act") sets forth the procedures for the creation of a community redevelopment agency; and

WHEREAS, as provided in the Redevelopment Act, 163.357, the City may declare itself to be the community redevelopment agency for any area of the City determined to be a community redevelopment area pursuant to the Redevelopment Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Board of Commissioners of the Community Redevelopment Agency. The City Council of the City of Parker declares itself to be the Community Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") for the City of Parker, Florida, for purposes of the Redevelopment Act. The members of the City Council shall be the members of the Agency, but such members constitute the head of a

legal entity, separate, distinct and independent from the City Council of the City of Parker.

Section 2. Powers. The powers of the Agency shall be exercised in accordance with and as contemplated by the Redevelopment Act. The Agency may employ an executive director, technical experts, and such other agents and employees, permanent and temporary, as it requires. The City Attorney for the City shall be counsel for the Agency; however, the Agency may employ or retain additional legal counsel, as it requires.


Section 3. Reporting. On or before March 31 of each year, the Agency shall prepare or have prepared a report that shall be filed with the City of Parker City Council reporting its activities for the preceding fiscal year, which shall include a complete financial statement setting forth its assets, liabilities, income and operating expenses of the end of such fiscal year.



Section 4. Appropriations. The City of Parker City Council may appropriate to the Agency such amounts as the City Council deems necessary for the administrative expenses and overhead of the Agency, including the development and implementation of community policing activities.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
