Discussion on sports park rebuild. Mr. Summerlin met with contractor last week and the surface of the courts are a concern. Overlaying the courts will probably on last about 2 years before cracks reappear and corners of courts are sagging. Recommend new foundations and could relocate at this time. To demo and move tennis court will be \$66,220 and to demo basketball court would be \$30982 and add more base to additional court for a total of \$111,000 approximately.

Discussion about distance of tennis courts from road, would like to see green spaces between courts, dog park, etc. for sidewalks. BCL would need additional 21 days to complete project with moving the tennis courts. Money will come off the total project, city will need to find more money to cover the costs. Fencing currently around each court, pickle ball will most likely need a fence between each court for safety.
