**Regular agenda:**

**1. Procurement Policy Discussion.** Ms. Galbreath requested changes to the policy as presented. If a business is barred, request that council is notified. Purchases less than \$3500 would not need a bid. Verbal quotes for purchases between \$3500 and \$25000. Over \$25000 to \$150000 written bids and over \$15000 out to bid. Need for the ability for department head to make emergency purchases in situations such as after a hurricane, and the possibility of a need for \$25000 allowed by department head.

First reading of updated ordinance will be on June 7<sup>th</sup> and second reading and possible adoption on June 21<sup>st</sup>.

**2. Ordinance for possible use of a golf cart in city limits.** Concern over young drivers using golf carts, licensed drivers are more likely to drive responsibly. 2 citations have been issued in Callaway to golf cart drivers. Discussions over LSV vs. golf car definitions and uses. Possibility of allowing golf carts in neighborhoods and not crossing major roadways. Education of uses and permits may be needed. Discussion of motorized bikes and side by sides. Straw vote taken to allow Mr. Sloan to rework the ordinance with the changes of only allowing golf carts on roads 20 mph or less, not allowed to cross major roads and in neighborhoods only:

Barrow – nay



**3. Discussion over a possible moratorium on new business in city limits.** Concern over main corridors of Business 98 and Tyndall Parkway. Would hinder potential buyers from coming into area. Talk of “formula business” limiting the number of the same type of business being allowed and within a certain distance of each other. A resolution can be done or the issues can be addressed in the LDR revisions that are currently underway. Special meeting with mobile home park owners and LDR discussion set for June 9 at 9 am.
