- 2. Discussion of the 5-year plan moving forward.** Ms. Galbreath passed out spreadsheet. Needs of public works are moved into an ARPA column, trash truck was approved Monday. Truck moved into ARPA column, \$19,000 for trench city wide, moved to ARPA, removed chipper, roller moved to ARPA column, patch trailer moved forward, engineer for permitting and gravel moved forward, tables, benches, security, sunshades move up, mower removed, repairing driveways to ARPA, stormwater drainage receives balance remaining of ARPA, \$35000 for preventing infiltration and inflow, maintain lines in remote areas moved forward, sewer camera and trailer \$125, 000 from ARPA, \$30000 for lift station pump replacement, \$8000 for hydrants, replace 23 valves \$12,000, \$20000 for hydrant replacement, \$85000 truck and utility

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trailer, \$15,000 tire machine, \$10000 for administrative department for codification and envelope machine. Additional \$72000 additional for stormwater repairs. Would like to look at financing the transmitters, proposing to ask Mayor Kelly to get a grant for fire truck and have \$50000 from selling of truck to use as part of grant. Grant writer is needed. Mr. Summerlin feels that some of the stormwater plan projects can be done in house, which would allow for the labor to be classified as the 25% match. Ms. Galbreath would like to look at grant money for police cars. Ms. Gibson reminded us that a force main and lift station is going to be needed on Tyndall Parkway to allow future business to come into the area. Mr. Summerlin stated that Parkway Garden may not be built but their water capacity is held for future building. Ms. Galbreath read ARPA guidance and allocation of funds and agrees with allowance of use.

Motion to purchase truck two days ago, amended making second motion to reach out to the bank to take out a loan on the needed trash truck by Ms. Galbreath and seconded by Ms. Gibson.

Mr. Chaple would like to add a Memorial Day event to the next agenda. Clerk will add upcoming budget workshops to the next agenda under upcoming events. Ms. Galbreath will assist Mr. Summerlin with the 5-year plan.
