

## RESOLUTION NO. 2023-393

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF PARKER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker has complied with and held a public hearing as required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Bay County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Parker.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Levy.

The Fiscal Year 2023=2024 operating millage rate for the City of Parker is 3.00 mills. This levy of a millage rate is the first time the City has levied an ad valorem tax. Therefore, the rolled-back rate is 0 mills and the final adopted rate represents a 100% increase over the rolled-back rate. For each fiscal year thereafter, the millage rate shall be adopted by subsequent resolution in accordance with Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes, as may be amended or superseded.

## SECTION 2. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, word or provision of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, whether for substantive, procedural, or any other reason, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions.

All resolutions or portions thereof of the City of Parker, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

## SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
