Ms. Barrow makes a motion that the council approve the lot split with Ms. Galbreath seconding the motion

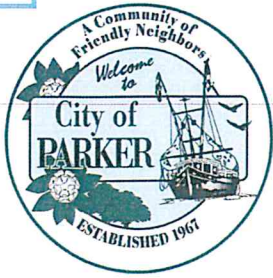
Council votes unanimously to approve the motion
