

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-398

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO GRANT AN EASEMENT TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENOR'S ERRORS AND CONSTRUCTION; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") proposes to construct or improve State Road No. 30 (US 98), Financial Project No. 4426671, in Bay County, Florida:

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain real property, more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto ("Property"), now owned by the City of Parker, Florida ("City"), be used temporarily by FDOT;

WHEREAS, said use is in the best interest of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT has requested that City grant the FDOT temporary permission to construct the project according to current construction plans, and said request has been duly considered.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The request of the FDOT for a temporary easement to construct the project according to current construction plans is granted, being for transportation purposes which are in the public or community interest and for the public welfare. The Mayor on behalf of the City is authorized to execute and deliver to FDOT a temporary easement in form acceptable to City and FDOT a temporary construction easement on the Property.

Section 2. A certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to the State of FDOT at Tallahassee, Florida.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, word or provision of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, whether for substantive, procedural, or any other reason, such portion shall be deemed separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. If any

penalty of this section is deemed inconsistent with any Florida statute, the provisions of the Florida Statute shall prevail.

Section 4. The correction of typographical errors which do not affect the intent of the Resolution may be authorized by the City Clerk or the Clerk's designee, without public hearing.


Section 5. This Resolution shall be liberally construed in order to effectively carry out the purposes hereof which are deemed not to adversely affect public health, safety, or welfare.

Section 6. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City of Parker, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
